

Tuition Rates 2016–17

Primary Division

Movers & Groovers

Offered once a week in eight-week sessions throughout the school year. You may enroll your child in as many sessions as you like. Tuition is \$96 per session or \$12 per class. The registration fee is \$20.

Creative Movement $I \not \odot II / Pre$ -Ballet $I \not \odot II$ Offered once a week for a monthly tuition of \$60. The registration fee is \$60.

Elementary Division

Grades I, II, III & Advanced Grade III

Students are required to take at least two classes per week. The registration fee is \$90.

Individual Classes

Adult students unable to attend on a regular basis may pay for individual classes. The cost per class is \$15 for Elementary Division, \$20 for Advanced Division. Classes can be paid for in advance by purchasing a class card. There is a \$35 registration fee.
